

As part of our commitment to providing a rich reading environment for our students, regardless of lockdown, we will be celebrating World Book Day once again on Thursday 4th March.

Our theme is simply: Back to Books!



Throughout the day, teachers will be providing a range of activities that students can choose from that do not involve screens or computers. This provides not only a chance for our students to enjoy reading and doing creative tasks but to spend much needed time away from the screen.

Although much of the day will be spent away from the screen, there will be some short videos and a Google Meet (for Y1 to Y6) at the beginning and end of the day with their class teacher available for all students in each class to attend.
