UNIFORM

Changes in uniform policy to make it more affordable, including:

- Only one pair of trainers needed
- Removal of winter / summer kit requirements
- Reduction in number of compulsory uniform items
- Removal of requirement to buy school trousers from Bede shop



Growth in second hand uniform provision in the academy

If you are unable to pay for uniform or want support with financial hardship, assistance may be available.

FOOD

Good value meals, including meal deal which is funded by Free School Meal allocation

If you are unable to pay for school meals, assistance may be available.

SIXTH FORM

Sixth Form bursary fund

If you are unable to pay for any activity related to sixth form provision (residential, university visits, resources, work experience etc), assistance may be available.

RESOURCES

Provision of £50 uniform voucher to all eligible y7 students



Provision of uniform vouchers on request for all other eligible students



Low cost stationary packs provided for students who lack essential equipment



Free provision of sanitary products



Revision books and resources provided free for all eligible students

If you are unable to pay for any resources your child needs (revision guides, stationary, IT access, internet access etc), assistance may be available.

ENRICHMENT

Financial support with trips and payment plans

If you are unable to pay for any enrichment opportunity (trips, visits, sports equipment, music tuition etc), assistance may be available.
